• Peddler Law Update: Mayor Vogt stated that he will make the village attorney's recommended changes to the proposed law and set the public hearing for the Oct. 20 meeting.

• Local Law to Override Tax Cap: Mayor Vogt asked the Board to consider overriding the tax cap for the 2016-17 budget year. He noted that the assessments alone put the Village over the 2015-16 tax cap, and that was with a barebones budget. The Board will think over proposal and discuss it in October.

 Server Problem/Purchase: Clerk Aldrich explained that the server had gone down and that the mother board is being replaced. However, that is only a short-term fix and that because of the servers age the server will either need to be replaced with a new one or the Village should go to a Cloud backup system. The temporary fix will cost about \$1,500. The Board asked Clerk Aldrich to get quotes for server replacement and a Cloud backup system. • Letter from County re. Return of Village Taxes to County Treasurer: Clerk Aldrich briefed the Board that the Village collected about \$2 million, with \$156,929 still owed.
